Description and growing: The bean is a low green bean (turkish bean in Estonian). It branch off pretty much. Have been growing for own family use since we got them.

Is the same plant cultivated some other place: No information (most likely not)

Usage: It does not develop so that it get fibers. Gently boil it and put into the deep freezer. Do not add salt. When you take it out of the deep freezer you should boil it a little. After you have boiled it you can gently fry it on a pan with butter and it is ready.

Tiiu and Anto life story: Worked as a teacher in Kadrina. We got them about 40 years back from then we started to call them Aunt Nõmme's beans.

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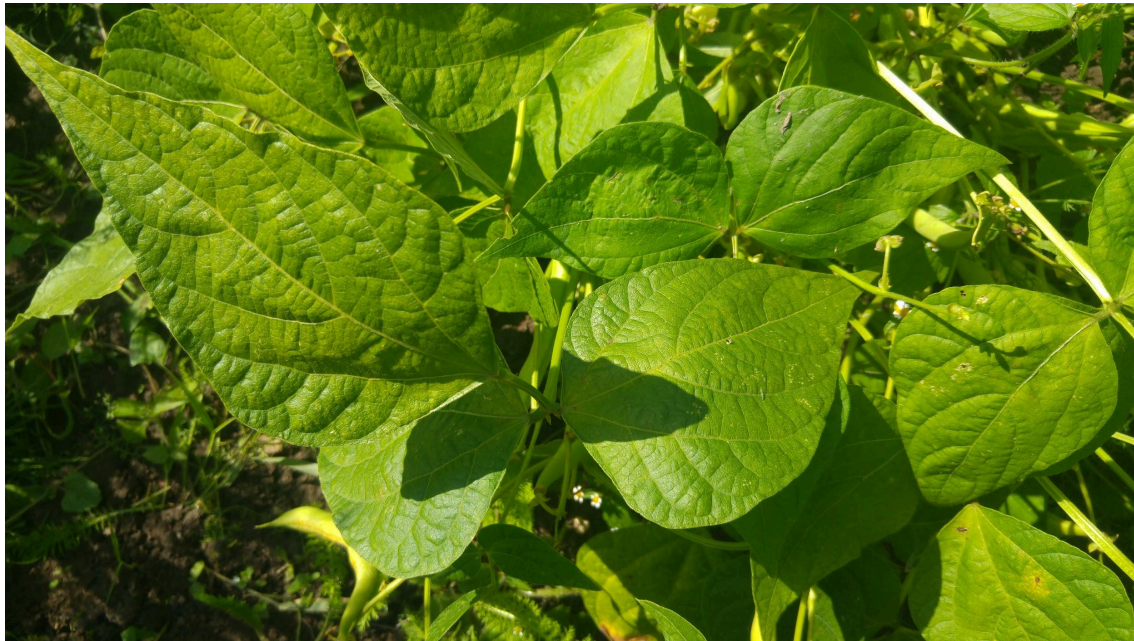
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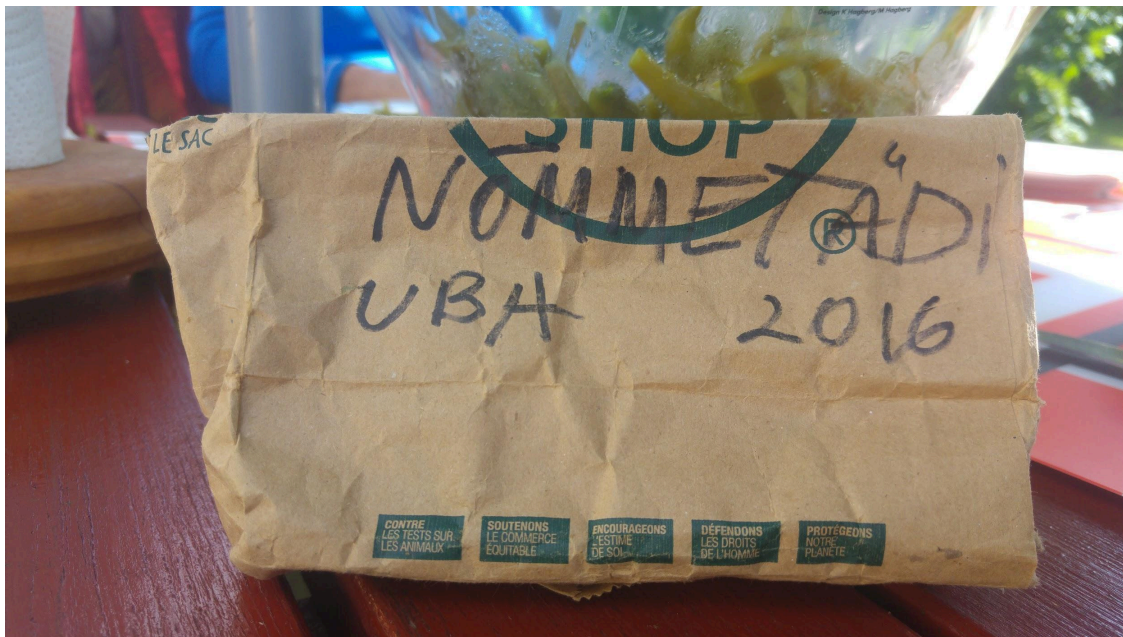
